



What is a Workplace Champion?

A Workplace Champion is a volunteer within a workplace who is trained and supported by MVIP to be the nonjudgmental friendly face who work colleagues can approach if they are witnesses, victims or perpetrators of Family Violence and need to find some help.

- There can be more than one Workplace Champion in any one workplace.
- Workplace Champions are trained on how to offer first support and on how to find the right agencies to help the person make contact with.
- They are trained and supported by Deedee, Liz and Nikki from MVIP.

Training & Other Requirements

Workplace Champion volunteers need to complete a module of three training sessions. Modules are run twice a year. If any of the sessions are missed during the first module they can be caught up during a later one. Volunteers are required sign a model release form for their poster portrait.

Training Sessions

(A combination of live and zoom sessions including Q&A's)

- 1. Introduction to MVIP and Speaker from "It's Not OK".
- 2. Learn how to get help for one of your colleagues.
- 3. Learn about and meet the faces of the partner Agencies that can help.
